TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Upon reading the Plaintiff's Verified Complaint on file herein along with the Ex-Parte Application for a Temporary Restraining Order and/or Preliminary Injunction and it appearing therefrom to the Court that this is a proper instance for the issuance of a Temporary Restraining Order and that unless restrained and enjoined by Order of this Court, immediate and irreparable injury and damage will result to the Plaintiff, CRISPIN LEYSER before a hearing on Plaintiff's Motion for a Preliminary Injunction; the Court finding that Plaintiff has complied with NRCP 65 and met his burden herein, Plaintiff being represented by David Z. Chesnoff, Esq., and Richard A. Schonfeld, Esq., of the law offices of CHESNOFF & SCHONFELD; counsel for named



1 Plaintiff herein, the Court being advised of the attempts to notify named Defendant JAMIE  
 2 GOLD either directly or through his counsel of the impending legal action, the Court being  
 3 convinced that Defendant Gold either has or will in the immediate future attempt to transfer the  
 4 \$12,000,000 being held by the Rio Hotel and Casino and/or its parent corporation to an unknown  
 5 account without providing Plaintiff with \$6,000,000, and good cause appearing therefor,  
 6

7 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that named Defendant, his  
 8 servants, employees, successors, representatives, and assigns, and the Rio Hotel and Casino  
 9 and/or its parent corporation or affiliate corporation(s), be and they are hereby restrained and  
 10 enjoined in any manner, either directly or indirectly, from encumbering, transferring or  
 11 attempting to transfer or otherwise dispose of \$6,000,000 of the money on deposit or being held  
 12 as a result of Jamie Gold prevailing in first place at the 2006 World Series of Poker main event.  
 13 Said funds are situated in Clark County, Nevada, and this Order takes immediate effect provided  
 14 Plaintiff give security in the sum of \$ 1,000<sup>00</sup> for payment of costs or damages as may  
 15 be incurred by any party who is found to have been wrongfully enjoined or restrained by such  
 16 Temporary Restraining Order directed to named Defendant Jamie Gold.  
 17

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order shall expire within fifteen (15) days after  
 19 entry, unless within such time the Order, for good cause shown, is extended, or unless  
 20 Defendants consent that it may be extended for a longer period.

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED the Application for  
 23 Temporary Restraining Order and/or Preliminary Injunction is hereby set for hearing on the  
 24 1<sup>st</sup> day of September 2006, at the hour of 9:00 o'clock in Department 4 of the  
 25 above-entitled Court and that notice of this hearing and the time and place thereof shall be given  
 26 to the Defendant no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2006;


